- 1. **1. Read 2 Cor. 9:1-5.** Why does Paul state that writing to the Corinthians about the collection for the saints in Jerusalem was superfluous? Was his writing actually superfluous or was it necessary? Explain.
  - a. **Read Heb. 10:24.** Why did Paul tell the Macedonians about the collection being taken up in Corinth?
  - b. **Read 2 Cor. 8:6-7.** What should this collection be a response to? How should this reflect in our lives?

- 2. **Read 2 Cor. 9:6-7.** What does it mean that reaping is proportionate to sowing? Why is it important that giving be both willing and cheerful?
- "...leads to blessings in our lives..."
- 3. **3. Read 2 Cor. 9:8-11** (Ps. 112:9 cited). Here we see that should a person be led by the Spirit to be generous; God will do what in response? Contrast this with James 4:3. How will those giving generously be enriched?
- "...meets the needs of others..."
- 4. **4. Read 2 Cor. 9:12.** The act of giving performs two actions. What are these two actions?
- "...and brings glory to God."
- 5. **Fead 2 Cor. 9:13-15.** How does giving to the church correlate to others worshiping God? How does this promote unity?
